In 2012 Tavistock Ramblers will be heading "up North" for their walking holiday.

We will be going to the Yorkshire Dales, an area to which the group have not been before.

Our hotel is in Thwaite, which is at the head of Swaledale. The Kearton Country Hotel was once home to Cherry Kearton, one of the world's first wildlife photographers in the 1890's, and is now a family run business in the same ownership for more than 25 years.

We will be staying there from Friday 11th May 2012 to Friday 18th May 2012. There will be a varied programme of walks in and around Swaledale and neighbouring Wensleydale. There will be the opportunity to include Swaledale's historic "capital", Richmond, possibly the famous Settle to Carlisle railway and the well known waterfalls of the area.

Paul is planning the walks which will be led by himself and Judy together with help from other members of the group.

Accommodation is on a half board basis and the costs will be £375 per person. Rooms are limited and so will be allocated on a strict first come first served basis. In particular, preference will have to be given to single travellers who are prepared to share.

A deposit of £50 per person is required and must be paid as soon as possible to reserve a place. The balance will become payable in March 2012.
